- Reading every night
- Writing the shopping list for you
- Practicing joined handwriting

- Practicing phonics sounds and writing words which include these sounds.

You could help your child with their Theme learning by:

- Take part in the Big Bird watch as a family.
- Talk about any coastal areas you have visited
- Visit the coast
- Learn the ocean song [Five Oceans Song](#)
- Take photographs on a phone or ipad and edit them
- Use playdoh to practice sculpting techniques

You could help your child with their Maths learning by:
Playing recall games using number facts to 10 and 20

Roll the dice and double the number
Learn the multiplication facts for 2 5 10 times tables
Practicing writing the numbers the correct way.

Phonics:

We will also have a huge focus on Phonics and Reading. Year 2 are ploughing through their sounds, and this is supporting their spelling!
