- To learn number facts up to 1000.
- To recap learning of the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables.
- To start to learn our 4 times table.

You could help your child with their Maths learning by:

- Practicing times tables 4's including division facts.
- Practice counting in tens through hundreds.
- Adding and subtracting across 100.
