The title of our current History unit is

'What did the Ancient Egyptians believe?'

Our Mathematics Learning

This half-term we will be working...

- To recognise that perimeter is the distance around the edge of a 2-D shape.
- To know that perimeter is measured in units of length.
- To recognise that the perimeter of a rectangle can be calculated by addition and multiplication.
- To develop our knowledge and recall of 3x, 6x and 9x tables.
- To use knowledge of the 3x, 6x and 9x table to solve problems.
- To explain the relationship between multiples of 3 and multiples of 6.

You could help your child with their Maths learning by:

- Practising times tables including division facts.
- By the end of Year 4, the majority of children should know their times tables up to 12x12, in order, out of order and division facts.

In Science our new unit is States of Matter. We will compare and group materials according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. We will learn about the water cycle and the link between evaporation and temperature. We will investigate which materials can exist in multiple states.
