- Reading with them every night and signing their Reading Record.
- Practise their weekly spellings and checking their ability to spell the Year 3 and Year 4 words.

Our Mathematics Learning

This half-term we will be working...

- How to express quantities made up of whole numbers and a fractional part.
- To compare and order mixed numbers using fraction sense.
- To subtract a proper fraction from a mixed number (converting to an improper fraction first).

You could help your child with their Maths learning by:

- Practising times tables.
- By the end of Year 4, the majority of children should know their times tables up to 12x12, in order, out of order and division facts.
