Our English Learning

This half-term your children will be writing and composing different genres, including:

- Dialogue from the perspective of characters from the Highwayman
- Setting description
- Letter.
- Non-chronological report on global warming and climate change.
- Our focus text for guided reading will be 'Tyger'

You could help your child with their English learning by:

- Helping them to learn their weekly spellings from the Y5-6 word list. Checking that they can write the correct spelling when you say the word.
- Encourage you child to read every night, asking them questions about the text and listening to them share their opinions about the books they have read.

The children will also learn about key features in the local area which link back to the taught curriculum

 As a family, you could explore aspects of Radcliffe from the 17th and 18th century and plot the features of the local area that link to feature from 'The Highwayman' by Alfred Noyes.

Our Mathematics Learning

This half-term, through NCETM and White Rose, we will be learning, amongst other things:

- To understand numbers with different decimal places.
- To find a gap between a positive and a negative number.
- To add and subtract numbers with mixed amounts of decimal places
- To solve 1d.2dp x 2d and solve any 4d ÷ 2d
- The relationships between radius, diameter and circumference in a circle.
- To reflect and translate shapes.
- To convert kg and g in both directions and to 3dp.
- To measure the angles in a triangle and find missing angles.

You could help your child with theirMaths learning by:

- Ensuring that they can recite their times tables and division facts out of order and at speed.
- Ask them to show you what they have been learning in Maths at school, and help them to explain the methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.
- Helping them to calculate total costs and change needed when shopping, or time taken to wait for a bus or tram, or calculating the time between your favourite family TV programs.
