Are you paying for school dinners or sending your child with a packed lunch?

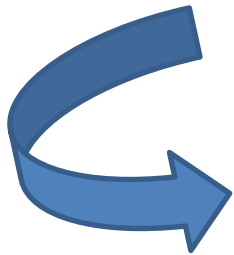
You may qualify for FREE SCHOOL MEALS!

PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING

IF YOU GET ANY OF THE FOLLOWING, REGISTERING FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS WILL GIVE ST. JOHN'S ADDITIONAL MONEY TO SPEND ON YOUR CHILD'S EDUCATION



**This additional money is called Pupil Premium.
For every child registered, St. John's will
receive an extra £1320.**



- Income Support
- Income-Based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (Provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

If you register for Free School Meals (even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2) it means our school will receive the extra funding which will benefit your child.

Your child will then be entitled to Free School Meals from Year 3 onwards. If you do not want your child to have Free School Meals, St. John's will still receive the additional money.
