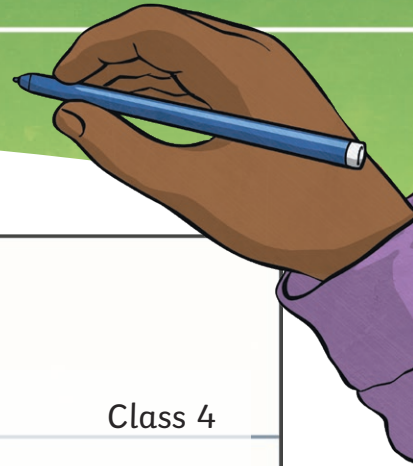

Dear Lionesses,

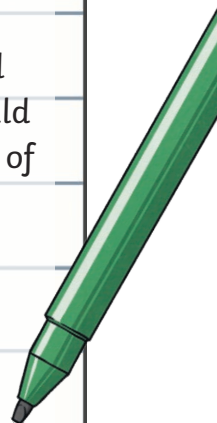
