

Measles is not just a little rash - it can be dangerous, especially for young children and babies

Measles is about in Greater Manchester. It spreads quickly and easily so it is highly likely there will be more cases

Vaccination is the best way to protect your child

Check your child's red book/ask your GP practice if you think your child has not had all theirs. Two doses are needed for full protection.

If you have not been fully vaccinated you can protect your child and others by getting it done, speak to your GP practice if you are not sure.

If you think your child may have measles keep them at home. Contact your GP or NHS111 for advice – to help stop it spreading phone ahead before taking your child to see a health professional.
