FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Registering for free school meals will enable your child to have a free meal each day and will provide the school with extra money.

If you are entitled, registering for free meals could raise an extra £1,320 per child for school to fund additional and valuable support.

This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving certain benefits. It is important to sign up for free school meals, even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 or if they bring a packed lunch so that school receives as much funding as possible.

Qualifying benefits are:

- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your earned income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income Support
- income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- income-related Employment Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, providing you are do not get Working Tax Credit, and your annual gross income is less than £16,190
- guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
